Vehicle Extrication and Rescue Tools:

The classroom segment will present information on New Vehicle Anatomy, hybrid vehicles, Vehicle Extrication Techniques, and a review of vehicle fires. The morning program will conclude with various auto manufacturers showing off their new hybrid technologies.

The afternoon will start out with a BANG! Various air bags will be deployed in order to give participants a real life experience with the sound, speed and smoke created when an air bag deploys. Outside evolutions will also cover extrication techniques that will keep you safe when operating around today's more advanced vehicles. These exercises will also allow participants to get a copious amount of hands-on experience with various hydraulic rescue tools.

Coordinated Fire Operations:

Essential Operations of the First Due

Engine and Truck at Private Dwellings

This two day hands-on class will focus on the initial tactical priorities of the first due engine and truck companies. The course is designed to help students identify and prioritize tactical objectives as they relate to a coordinated fire attack. During these intensive two days students will rotate through multiple skills stations where they will receive instruction on the primary functions of the first due engine and truck. Evolutions will focus on forcible entry, search, ventilation, stretching the initial line, fire attack, engine company emergencies, victim removal and much more. Day two will conclude with live fire scenarios that are designed to put it all together. For those of you who have previously participated in either of our stand alone engine or truck classes are encouraged to sign up for this dynamic offering. This class is recommended for fire officers and firefighters and is limited to (30) students.

Full turnout gear with SCAB with spare bottle required.

Two Day Class: Saturday, November 7 and Sunday, November 8

Basic Pump Operations:

This full day class will focus on pumping principles and practices. This program will include multiple line operations, water supply challenges, pumping emergencies; including governor failures, what to do if the pump will not engage, and foam system operation with the practical application of foam. The majority of the day will be spent operating pumps in a field environment. Classroom discussion will be minimal.

The course is designed for a student that has completed the State of Connecticut Pump Operator Certification or a pump operator that has strong field experience. We encourage participants to bring a pump from their department. This will give you the opportunity to learn more about your piece of equipment. The program will conclude with a "friendly" competition.
